NOMINATION GUIDELINES - Nominations are being accepted through March 4, 2016.

Nominees must work in Venango County and be 18-39 years of age. Nominees should participate in civic activity that impacts Venango County, outside of their professional position/job. These activities can include community projects, advocacy, volunteerism, charitable deeds, and outstanding acts of kindness

The Review Committee may contact you for additional information about your nominee. Nominees will be selected based on their overall civic achievement and community impact as well as on how their lives are an **example of the FLEX mission**. Nominees do not need to be a member of FLEX or the Venango Area Chamber of Commerce.
